Oakland Civil Rights Attorney Dan Siegel has successfully litigated numerous academic discrimination cases, including the recent Title IX gender discrimination case against CSU-Fresno which resulted in a \$5.8 million award for plaintiff Linda Vivas. Siegel also represents plaintiff Diane Milutinovich in her Title IX claim against Fresno State. Ms. Milutinovich is one of the confirmed speakers for the 2007 WAGE forum.
